

LEVEL/BOOK 2 SCRIPTS

Scene #1

G.O.D. COMMANDER – Mission control, this is G.O.D. Command Central, do you read me?

BUDDY – Read you loud and clear.

G.O.D. COMMANDER - There is a little girl in need of your help. Her name is Hope, and her family has lost all of theirs. She is very sick. I need you to bring them the hope found in Me.

ADA – Okay, just tell us where to go.

CHAD – I'm a little nervous. We've never done THIS before.

CARLEY – Just remember, Chad, it's not you, but the Holy Spirit at work through you. Don't depend on your ability. Depend on His.

NARRATOR -- Find Hope.

Scene #2 – The Hospital



(The kids walk into HOPE's hospital room. HOPE is very sick and weak, lying in her bed.)

HOPE – (softly) Oh, Hi. I'm Hope.

CHAD – Hi Hope, I'm Chad and this is Buddy, Ryan, Carley, and Ada.

HOPE – It's so nice to meet all of you. (she takes a long breath, then continues weakly) I don't get out too much anymore, so it's nice to see some friendly faces.

CARLEY – That's why we're here. We've come to tell you that God loves you and doesn't want you to be sick.

HOPE – Thank you. (sighs) I know that God loves me, but if it wasn't in His plan for me to be sick, then I wouldn't be. He wants to bring glory to himself through my life, however short it may be.

RYAN – That's where you're wrong, Hope! God doesn't WANT anyone to be sick, and His glory comes from you pulling out of this.

CHAD – What kind of loving God would ever want His children to be sick? It just doesn't make sense.

ADA – It makes a lot more sense that He would want us well so we can do what He has for us.

CARLEY – You were born for a reason. You have a purpose.

ADA – And you are also promised a long life. We believe that He wants to show you that His power is even greater than sickness and despair.

HOPE – I...I've never heard all of that. I kind of...thought this was the way God wanted it. People are praying and nothing seems to be happening, so I just assumed...

CARLEY –YOU have to believe it too, Hope. It's ok to feel upset. Even angry, when something bad happens. But remember, Jesus can do amazing things! There are even stories in the Bible just like yours! In fact, Jesus ALSO faced death. But then, He turned it into the greatest victory in all history! . You can't pray God's will without knowing what it is. Read the Bible. Find those promises in God's Word. See that you're not alone. Pray, and BELIEVE that it can happen for you, too.

BUDDY – Bad things happen sometimes, but we can have faith that God will be there for us through it all, even when we don't seem to see it. We don't live by what we see. We live by what God says.

CARLEY: Faith is believing in our heart that we will get what we hope for. It is being sure of what we cannot see.

HOPE – (amazed) Well, that definitely makes more sense.

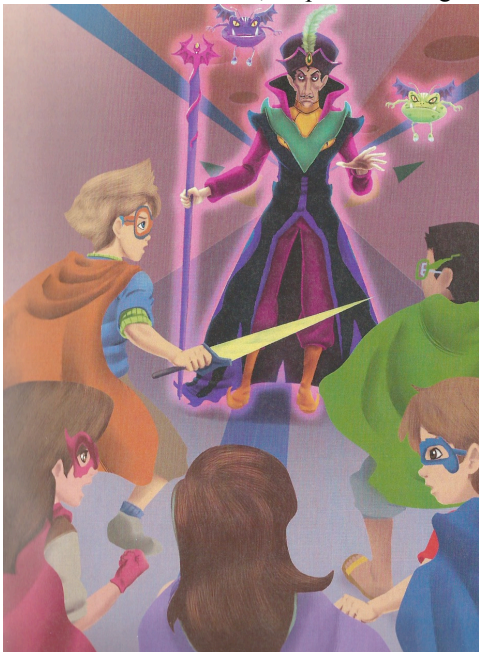
RYAN – As much as your mom and dad love you, God loves you even more. As much as this pains them, it pains God too. Jesus didn't just pay the price with His life just so you could go to heaven. He came to give you a great life. He came to bring you....well....hope!

HOPE – (soft laugh) I think you're right. It certainly doesn't feel good, thinking that there's no chance for me. I don't think those thoughts are coming from God.

CHAD – Exactly. Can we pray for you? God, we pray for Hope and thank you that you don't want her to be sick, that because of Jesus' sacrifice, she will never be alone. We know that you can do miracles, and we pray that Hope will be healed. We pray, God that you will show her who You really are, that she will know what you have for her life. Strengthen her and her parents as they walk through this, reminding them that You are with them all the way. In Jesus's name, amen.

HOPE'S MOM (ERICA) – That was beautiful, Chad.

CHAD – Now believe it, Hope. Receiving from God is all about faith.



Scene #3 – The Battle

(The Sultan of Sickness speaks in a low voice. Calm and calculating, and coldly sarcastic. He doesn't take the Spirit Heroes seriously, so he doesn't panic until near the end)

SULTAN – (chuckles) How dare you come around here talking about *hope*. These kids *have* no hope. And that's the way I intend to keep it.

ADA – You can't win here. Jesus already won for these kids. All they have to do is believe.

CHAD – Yeah, get out of here.

SULTAN – (sighs) Or what?

CARLEY – Or we'll have no choice but to destroy you.

SULTAN – (he's almost bored) You wimpy kids don't scare me.

(sarcastically) Spirit Heroes, right? (laughs) What a joke!

BUDDY – We don't come in our own power. We come in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.

SULTAN – (caught off guard, now he's worried) Er, uh....p-please don't say that name.

CHAD – Spirit Heroes, prepare for battle! Clothed with God's armor and armed with the power of the Holy Spirit and the Word of God, we will destroy you.

BUDDY – God's word says in Isaiah 53:5, "He was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. He was beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed."

SULTAN – (groans) Oh my, that one did hurt a little bit. (shakes himself off and tries again) Then how do you explain all the people that aren't healed? (growing more sure, he smiles evilly) It sure doesn't look like Hope is going to make it through this one.

RYAN – Second Corinthians 5:7, "For we live by believing and not by seeing. We don't live by what we see, but by believing the promises of God."

SULTAN – (yells in pain) Yowzers, that was a stinger! (ragged breaths)... but you are all... disillusioned. God is not as great as you think! Look at all the bad he has caused in the world.

ADA – James 1:17. "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above."

CARLEY – And First Peter 5:8, "Be sober-minded, be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour." So it seems to me that good comes from God and bad comes from the devil.

SULTAN – (beginning to panic now, he begins to shout) It doesn't matter what you do or what you say, there's no hope for Hope! It's too late for her!

CHAD – You're a liar! Isaiah 55:11 says, "So shall my word be that goes out from my mouth, it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that, which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it." Go now in the name of Jesus.

SULTAN – Noooooo!!!! (death cry, fades away)

SULTAN – (please record a few fight effort/pain sounds for me)

Scene #4 – Spirit Heroes Headquarters.
(A girl walks into the room)

BUDDY – (confused) I'm sorry. I feel like we should know you... Your eyes and smile seem so familiar...

HOPE – (laughs) I'm Hope! You came and saw me at the hospital a few months back!

ALL (Yell) – Hope! What? Oh my gosh! (Etc)

ADA – I hardly recognized you, you look so different.

HOPE – That's why I came. I wanted to thank you all for coming that day. It completely changed my life. That day, I understood God for the first time. You gave me and my family hope when we had none left. (shyly) You don't know this, but that same day, the doctors came in and told my parents that it was very likely that I wouldn't survive.

RYAN – Oh wow! We had no idea.

HOPE – Because of you, I started searching for the promises of God in the Bible, and I believed them. And then... I was healed! The doctors say they have never seen anything like it.

CARLEY – Oh, Hope! What an amazing story.

HOPE - And because of this amazing miracle in my life, others have come to know Jesus and His goodness.

CHAD – Just the way it is supposed to be.

CARLEY – Hold on, I'm getting a message on my mobile spirit radio. Hey Hope, would you by any chance want to join the Spirit Heroes?

HOPE – Would I? Of course I would!

CARLEY – Okay! You will be...Glory Girl! You are a representative of the glory of God in the flesh. Your testimony has the power to change lives, and we would love to have you and your story as part of our team.

HOPE – Oh, I am so excited! It feels great to have found my purpose. It's like nothing I could have ever imagined.

CHAD – And it only gets better.

NARRATOR -- Find the Exit.

LEVEL 4 – TITAN OF TERROR AUDITION LINES

(confident) You slimy little Spirit Heroes. Give me a break! Heh heh. Besides...I've been working on my *karate*! Hiiiyaaaa!

(angry) I'm here to take back what was mine...Noah! I had him SO scared, and then YOU came in and ruined EVERYTHING!

(groveling and begging, scared) Please! Don't believe them. They...they don't know what they are talking about!
